

MINUTES OF A JOINT REGULAR MEETING OF THE

It was noted that a quorum of the Boards was present and the meeting was called to order.

Ms. Murphy advised the Boards that, pursuant to Colorado law, certain disclosures might be required prior to taking official action at the meeting.
